

#### What is an Emergency Work Order

1.	Stopped up toilet (if only 1 bathroom)
2.	AC/Heat not working in extreme temperatures (ex: AC not working in
	degree temps, Heat not working if 50 degrees or below.
3.	Water leaks inside the unit (not dripping faucets)
4.	Sewer or gas odors of any kind
5.	Exposed wiring
6.	Any damages causing sharp edges (broken windows, etc
7.	Any breach of security (broken windows, doors, screens, and locks)
8.	LockOut (to let them in but not to make a key)
9.	Assisting law enforcement, fire department, etc.
10.	No water at all (no hot water will not be considered an emergency)
11.	Major damage to the unit or a part of the unit (ex: ceiling fell in, toilet fell
	through floor, etc.)
12.	Fire
13.	Any other item hat would pose a health & safety risk to residents or guests

If the above does not apply to your work order then the order will be taken care of once ALL EMERGENCY ORDERS ARE COMPLETED.




#### Juneteenth

June 19, 1865 marks the day freedom finally came to Texas. Union Major General Gordon Granger and some 2000 Union troops arrived in Galveston, Texas to inform the more than 250,000 enslaved black people in the state that they were free by executive decree.

It can include coverage for their replacement cost or actual cash value that includes depreciation. This is a camp for kids ages 6-12. I will have space for 15 kids


