Winter Weather Preparation

Reminder: when the heaters are turned on for the first time there could be a smell of something burning due to build up of dust and lint on the coils and once it burns off it will stop.

If the temperature is freezing or below to make sure the heat is on and all lower cabinet doors are open to let heat circulate around pipes and to keep the kitchen and bath faucets dripping. If you do not do these items and pipes freeze and bust they will be charged for repairs.

Do not remove outside faucet covers at any time. If they are removed it could cause building pipes to freeze and bust.

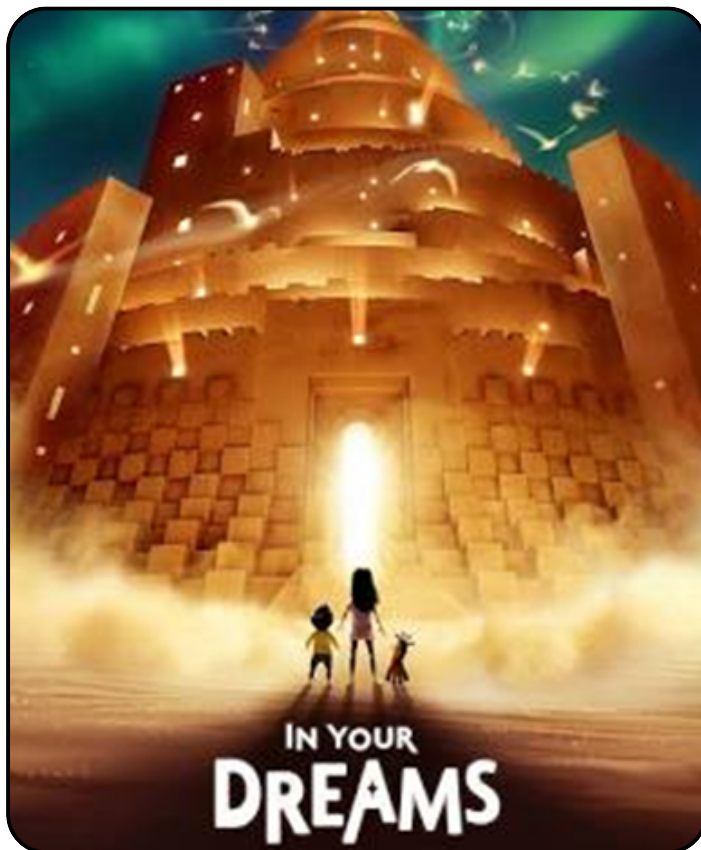

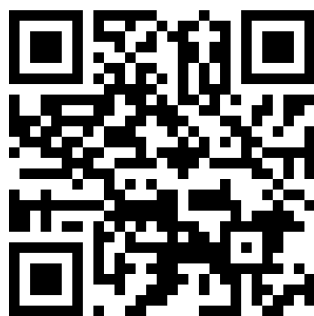

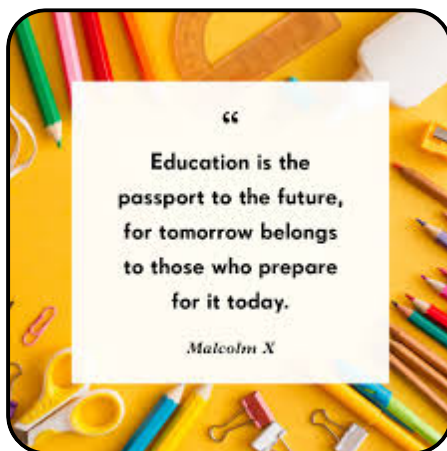
