AHA Staff will be monitoring and lease violations will be issued for non-compliance.

Pet Policy

- All pets must be approved in advance by AHA. The pet owner is required to submit an application, pay all applicable fees/dues before the pet is brought onto the premises.
- The owner must provide AHA a certificate from a licensed veterinarian/designated state or local authority that states the pet has received the required vaccinations. Also, a statement from a licensed veterinarian that the animal is good health, has no communicable diseases and the pet(s) has been spayed or neutered.
- All pets must be on leash when outside.

Transfer Request Policy Stated in the AHA Policy Packet

H. TRANFERS- (966.4© (3)

7. PHA will consider Tenant requests for transfer in accordance with the transfer priorities established in the Admissions and Occupancy Policies.

Admissions and Occupancy Policy: 12-III.C. ELIGIBILITY FOR TRANSFERS

Transferring residents do not have to meet the admission eligibility requirements pertaining to income or preference. However, the PHA may establish other standards for considering a transfer request [PH Occ GB, p. 150].

PHA POLICY

- 1. Have not engaged in criminal activity that threatens the health and safety of residents and staff
- 2. Owe no back rent or other charges, or have a pattern of late payment
- 3. Have no housekeeping lease violations or history of damaging property
- 4. Can get utilities turned on in the name of the head of household (applicable only to properties with tenant-paid utilities)

School-aged kids can meetup to free-build with LEGO at the library in this after school series.


Tired of stepping on loose LEGO at home? Come down to the Mockingbird library this Fall, build to your heart's content, and leave the loose LEGO to the librarians!
