EXECUTIVE SESSION

In accordance with Texas Government Code, Subchapter D:

(Litigation/Consultation with Attorney) Section 551.071

HACA Public Facility Corporation (HACAPFC) may seek advice from its attorney regarding a pending or contemplated litigation, a settlement offer, or on a matter in which the duty of the attorney representing the AHA under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas clearly conflicts with Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

In addition to any other item that is described on the Agenda, the following are pending or contemplated litigation subjects which may be discussed in Executive Session:

(Personnel) Section 551.074

HACAPFC may deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of public officers or employees, Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer.

(Real Property) Section 551.072

HACAPFC may deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property in a closed meeting when deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the governmental body in negotiations with a third person.

(Business Prospect/Economic Development) Section 551.087

HACAPFC may discuss or deliberate on commercial or financial information that has been received from a business prospect that the AHA seeks to conduct economic development negotiations with or deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to a business prospect.

(Deliberations about Gifts and Donations) Section 551.073

HACAPFC may deliberate a negotiated contract for a prospective gift or donation to the HACAPFC if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the HACAPFC in negotiations with a third person.

(Deliberations about Security Devices) Section 551.076

HACAPFC may deliberate the deployment, or specific occasions for implementation, of security personnel or devices.
